### Tennis Information and Rules

April 2018

**Court Bookings Priority Rule:** fixtures, social sessions and coaching commitments are entered on to the relevant Booking system in advance and take priority over general play. The committee reserves the right to cancel/move an individual booking in the event of a Club fixture being re-arranged. Where possible you will be informed in advance, so please keep your membership details up to date.

**Floodlight play:**

Court charge £2 per half hour from 3pm - 10pm in the Winter and 7pm - 10pm in the Summer (under 11's can book a court up to 7:30pm). There is no cost for day-time bookings, players are requested to respect coaching and not book at busy times.

*Booking entitles use of floodlights when required, the floodlight switches are located in the Squash Lobby. Unless there is a booking following the lights will turn off automatically at end of your session – but you can extend your booking time if the court is free. Members must login on the Club Solution website in order to book a court. If a court booking is made with a visitor, the visitor fee is charged automatically*

**Visitors** may play three times. It is the responsibility of the member to ensure that visitor's fees are paid before playing, either via booking on Club Solution or using stamps.

Visitor fee ( <i>if paid via online</i> )	<b>£2.50</b> per ½ hour for adults	<b>£1.50</b> per ½ hour Juniors ( <i>u 18</i> )

NB: No visitor's fee is required when playing in an LTA sanctioned tournament. The committee reserves the right to fine any member not paying for facilities in advance of play. Any fine not paid within 48 hours may result in an indefinite suspension at the Committee's discretion.

**Club and Social Play** operates on Sunday mornings from 10:00 until 12:30, and on Wednesday evenings from 6:30pm. Players are expected to 'mix in'. Doubles takes priority over singles. Beginners may not play in organised social sessions, but at other times have the same rights to courts as other members.

*Please note:* Tennis balls are only provided for matches and organised social sessions.

**Club Tournaments:** Winners are responsible for trophies and these must be returned to the Captain or Tournament Secretary one week before the following year's finals. Beginners cannot play in closed tournaments, other than handicap events. Juniors may play in a senior tournament if agreed with the Organiser or Tennis Captain.

**Nominated juniors** may enter senior tournament events and be asked to play senior matches for the club. Conduct on court is important as well as playing standard.

**Locking Up:** Last to leave – please check all outer doors are locked, windows closed and lights are turned off before leaving.

**Annual General Meeting's** are held before the Club's AGM usually last two weeks of November. Please refer to the fixtures lists and/or notice boards for dates.

**Notice Boards:** Each section has its own notice board where section specific events and news are displayed. Don't forget the general notice board in the bar area for news and social events open to all members.

**Problems** Refer to the relevant notice board, or your section brochure for a list of committee members – any problems or ideas should be discussed with them or with the Club Manager.

**Pay and Play** is not available.

**Clothing:** Recognised tennis clothing and tennis shoes please. i.e. no trainers with angled edges or standard shoes,

**Parents Please Note:** Juniors under the age of 12 must not be left on club premises unattended, a parent or responsible adult must be present.

**Keyfobs:** You are given a keyfob on joining the club. If you lose the fob you will be charged £10.00 for a replacement. If your Keyfob is faulty or broken it will be replaced free of charge – the broken fob must be returned to the club. *Under no circumstances should you give your fob to another person to allow entry to the club.*
